

Discord Basics

- To join the fun and interact with others, we're inviting you to join our Discord server.
On the convention site, virtual.fe.com, there's a tab called 'Discord & VR'
On that page you'll see the 'link to Discord' button; click on that to get started!
- The top left image (that's this controller-looking thingy) is how you access your direct messages and see the status of friend requests. It's where you add new friends.
- If you are a minor, we recommend activating parental controls. Go down to the little cog wheel next to your Discord ID on the bottom left, user setting, privacy & safety and choose the option 'keep me safe'.
- These icons on the left are the different servers you are in! Here is the Furnal Equinox server!
- Each server contains channels split into categories!
- First off, read the rules and agree to them by reacting with the checkmark emote
- And you're in!
- On the left is the entire list of channels and each channel has a description to help you understand their purpose.
- There are two types of channels, text and voice. Click once on the voice channel to join in!
- Convention info channels are there for us to put information in front of you, you can't write in those channels but you should check them out for announcements and updates!
- Some channels have pins that contain important information.
- The VIP channels are locked for people who have donated to our fundraising! If you need to be upgraded from 'attendee' to 'supporter' you can @ a mod and they will give you the appropriate role.
- You can right click on any channel you wish to mute

- Right clicking on another user will allow you to send them a friend request, direct message them or block them.
- You can @ any user by typing @ followed by their name and you can also reply directly to a previous message by clicking on 'reply' next to the message you want to reply to.
- The discord-help channel is there if you need it!
